Thank you so much for praying for the Howells. They made it safely to New Zealand, and we have been preparing them to oversee the work God has started at Harvest Baptist Chruch. We only had a week to get them ready before we had to leave. On top of that, we squeezed in a week long Holiday Bible Program (same as a Vacation Bible School). We really enjoyed the week we had with the Howells, and I know that they will do an awesome job. Please continue to pray for them as we know the devil will do all he can to discourage them and destroy a work that God has started.

What a blessing the Holiday Bible Program (HBP) was this year. This was only our second children's program since the church began two years ago. Last year we had twenty-three on the first day and a total of seventy-six children go through the program with two receiving Christ as their Savior. This year we had sixty on the first day, with a 103 total attendance, and ten asked Jesus to save them. It was an extremely hard week, but God truly blessed. We are so thankful for all that had a part in prayer, financial support, and assistance with the program. So many had a part this year, not only in New Zealand, but also in America; again, thank you.

We made it safely to America, and have started to re-accustom ourselves to the food and the driving. Believe it or not, our first meal was a good all-American hotdog. I have only made a few mistakes, by driving on the left side of the road. I know that I will soon be readjusted. Please keep us in prayer for travel safety as we begin our furlough.

We would like to be with everyone, but know that is not possible. Regardless of whether we are with you or not, please know that you are all in our prayers. Thank you for your continual prayers and support. Pray that souls will be saved during our travels.
