They are living in Hamilton (5 hours north) and are attending/serving in another Independent Baptist Church that we fellowship with. Two weeks later on April 1st, Laura, a young lady from our church, was married to Timothy. He is a Christian man from Colorado. She met Timothy while he was here on a working holiday. Guy performed the wedding for them and they are living here in New Zealand. Timothy has applied for a Working Visa to be able to stay here in the country and work.
