Debbie started another Bible study with two older ladies. It has been a real blessing. She is also doing Bible studies with three other ladies which keeps her busy. It is such a blessing to see these ladies applying what they are learning and really growing in the Lord.

October 14<sup>th</sup> we travelled to Hamilton (5 hours north) to participate in a Dedication Service for the new building of Fellowship Baptist Church, where our daughter Erin, and her husband (Rundell) attend. Our son-in-law, Rundell, did his first year of building apprenticeship, building this church. Fellowship Baptist is one of the sister churches that we fellowship for camps/retreats and they participate in the New Zealand Baptist Bible Training Program. It was a wonderful service.

Cody is finishing up his last year of NZBBTP in early December. He is planning on doing an internship with Harvest Baptist Church in Palmerston North for at least a year. He will be helping Logan run the church while we are on furlough next year. Cody is a real blessing to us, and we can see God mightily using him in the future.
